Creating Gay Health Messages That Work! Contest

I. PURPOSE

Frontiers Newsmagazine and the L.A. Gay & Lesbian Center announce an exciting opportunity for someone to be a renegade in the battle against HIV and STDs by creating a Gay Health Messages that Work! (poster, sign, hand card, flyer, advertisement or other method). Both Frontiers and the L.A. Gay & Lesbian Center recognize that HIV and sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) continue to impact the lives of members of our community, yet HIV does not appear to attract the same level of attention and urgency that it did in the early years of the epidemic—and the numbers of HIV and STD infections continue to grow. Frontiers and the Gay & Lesbian Center invite you to put your creativity and imagination to work to craft an advertising message that will reach gay men, inspire them to take charge of their health and reinvigorate the discussion of HIV in our community. Materials developed through the contest will be used to enhance HIV prevention efforts targeting the gay community in California.

II. CONTEST SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Contest participants will create an edgy, creative and relevant message aimed at preventing HIV and STDs.

These messages can be in the form of a poster, sign, hand card, flyer, advertisement or another method.

Complete the attached application and submit the application with both a hard copy and a digital file of your artwork (floppy/zip disk or compact disk).

Artwork submission specifications:

All files must be included when saving your submission. This includes EPS and/or TIFF files.

All printer and screen fonts must be included. Please provide all family member typefaces used in your files. This includes fonts in EPS.

For quality results, file should be set to output at 85 line screen and picture resolution should be between 150-200.

All 4-color submissions must be set to CMYK process color. No RGB.

All spot color submissions should be set to PANTONE.

Save all Photoshop files in CMYK mode or grayscale (No RGB).

Size of the submission should be no larger than 11.5 wide \times 14.25 high (69p \times 85p6 Picas). This is for a full bleed.

All artwork must be submitted no later than Friday, January 30, 2004.

Winners will be notified and presented with a cash prize at a ceremony hosted by the L.A. Gay & Lesbian Center and *Frontiers* at the Village at Ed Gould Plaza - February 18, 2004.
